

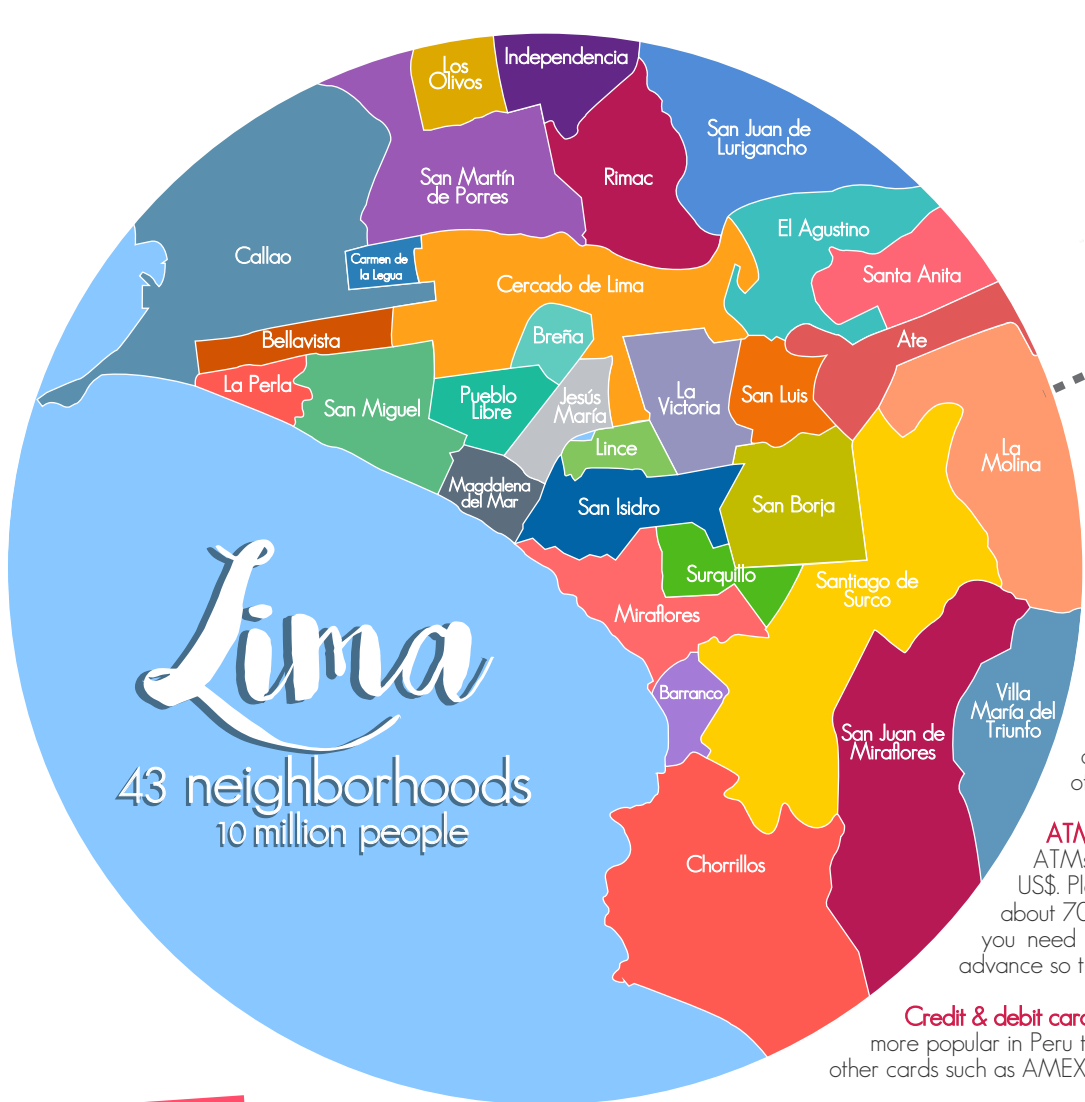

UNDERSTANDING THE BASICS



PERU

Currency: Peruvian Soles (s/.) or (PEN).

Languages: Spanish 84% (Official), Quechua 13%, Aymara 1.7%

Visas: Citizens of the U.S. and most other Western countries don't require a tourist visa. The maximum period of stay granted is 183 days (you will need to specifically ask the customs officer for more than 90 days, which is otherwise the default period of stay).

ATMs: Widely available in big cities and towns. ATMs will allow you to withdraw either Soles or US\$. Please note that most ATMs limit withdrawals to about 700 Soles per day (or the equivalent in US\$). If you need larger amounts of money, tell your bank in advance so they can raise your limit.

Credit & debit cards: Accepted at many businesses. Note: VISA is more popular in Peru than Mastercard, and very few places accept other cards such as AMEX.

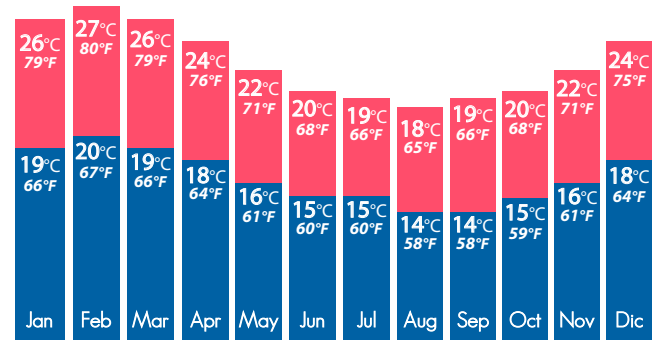

SALES TAX

IGV sales tax included in the price

Don't be fooled into paying more. All sale prices must include the IGV tax by law.

TIPPING

10% at restaurants

A 10% tip is suggested at restaurants. Tipping taxi drivers is not customary.

WATER

Stay safe: Faucet water is **NOT** drinkable in Peru. Instead, buy bottled water or boil faucet water before drinking it.

UNDERSTANDING THE BASICS



BOLETA OR FACTURA?

Which one do I need to ask for?

When you make a purchase, the person at the register will ask you: "Boleta o Factura?" You may find this hard to understand even if you speak Spanish fluently! These are technical names only used in Peru to refer to two types of receipts: "Boleta", which is given to consumers, and "Factura", which is only given to companies. Now that you know the difference, you can confidently reply: "Boleta, por favor" on your first purchase in Peru.



DON'T BRING TORN \$ BILLS

They won't be accepted anywhere

The Association of Banks of Peru has set strict regulations for foreign currency circulating in the market. As a result, no one will accept torn bills with a tear more than 1/2 centimeter. Nor will anyone accept a bill that has been stamped or written on. Most places prefer Peruvian Soles, but if for any reason you need to use US\$, our recommendation is to either bring in mint condition bills or simply get them at ATMs.



SAVE 18% TAX

on Peruvian hotels

Keeping your immigration card will grant you an automatic 18% IGV sales tax exemption at hotels during your stay. Please note that this exemption is only available for tourists and other non-residents and applies to hotels only.



WATCH OUT FOR YOUR CARD

when paying at restaurants

Even though it's not very common in Peru, card cloning is a rising problem around the world. Therefore, most restaurants and coffee shops have portable credit card terminals that are usually brought to your table so you always keep an eye on your card. If a restaurant doesn't have this type of device, we suggest you pay in person at the cash register instead of handing your card to the waiter.



\$ EXCHANGE

Never in the street

We strongly suggest exchanging money at "Casas de cambio" (money exchange bureaus), which often give better rates than banks and are much safer than changing money on the street, where counterfeit money is a problem.



ONLY TAKE AN OFFICIAL TAXI

when arriving at Lima's airport

When arriving in Lima, we recommend taking an official taxi from the "Taxi Green" kiosk counter located on the arrivals hall for 60 soles, or getting a taxi with your Uber app (connect for free to the airport wifi up to 30 minutes). We strongly discourage everyone (even locals) from getting a taxi in the street outside the airport, as they are informal and in many cases not safe to use.

PERUVIAN FOOD BASICS

Peruvian cuisine?

INCAN

Thousands of fruits, vegetables and tubers cultivated by indigenous peoples through thousands of years of culture & ancient traditions.



SPANISH & WEST AFRICAN

The Spanish colonization in 1528 brought Mediterranean, Moorish, and West African ingredients and cooking techniques that, combined with native traditions, gave birth to a new, colorful Criollo cuisine.



CHINESE

Dramatically impacted Peruvian food thanks to a new world of spices & flavors, first brought by Chinese workers in 1849.



JAPANESE

Since arriving in 1899, they have brought their cooking techniques and elegant aesthetic to refine existing dishes.

DISHES GUIDE

CRIOILLO FOOD

- **Anticucho:** Marinated beef heart skewered and seared over the grill.
- **Causa:** Smashed Andean potatoes mixed with aji and layered with seasoned meat (chicken, octopus, tuna, or shrimp) and vegetables.
- **Lomo Saltado:** Stir-fried marinated strips of sirloin, onions, tomatoes, and other herbs. Served with french fries and rice.
- **Aj de Gallina:** Thin strips of chicken mixed with a creamy yellow sauce made of aji, cheese, milk, bread, walnuts, and spices.
- **Rocoto Relleno:** Rocoto peppers stuffed with spiced beef, topped with cheese, and finally oven baked.
- **Pollo a la Brasa:** Peruvian-style roast chicken served with fries and salad. Usually eaten with an aji sauce.
- **Papa Rellena:** Large, deep-fried mashed potato dumpling stuffed with spiced beef, onions, and vegetables.
- **Arroz con Pollo:** Seasoned green rice with stewed chicken or duck.
- **Seco de Cordero:** Slow-cooked lamb stew in cilantro sauce served with seasoned white beans and white rice.
- **Tacu Tacu:** Rice and beans mixed together and pan fried into a slightly crunchy cake. Often served with lomo saltado on top.
- **Papa a la Huancaína:** Potatoes covered in creamy yellow sauce made with milk, cheese, aji, and herbs.
- **Pastel de Papa:** Layers of potatoes and Andean cheese, oven baked with a rich mixture of eggs, and milk poured over it.
- **Pan con Chicharrón:** Sandwich stuffed with braised and fried slices of pork, sweet potatoes, fresh chopped onions, and herbs.

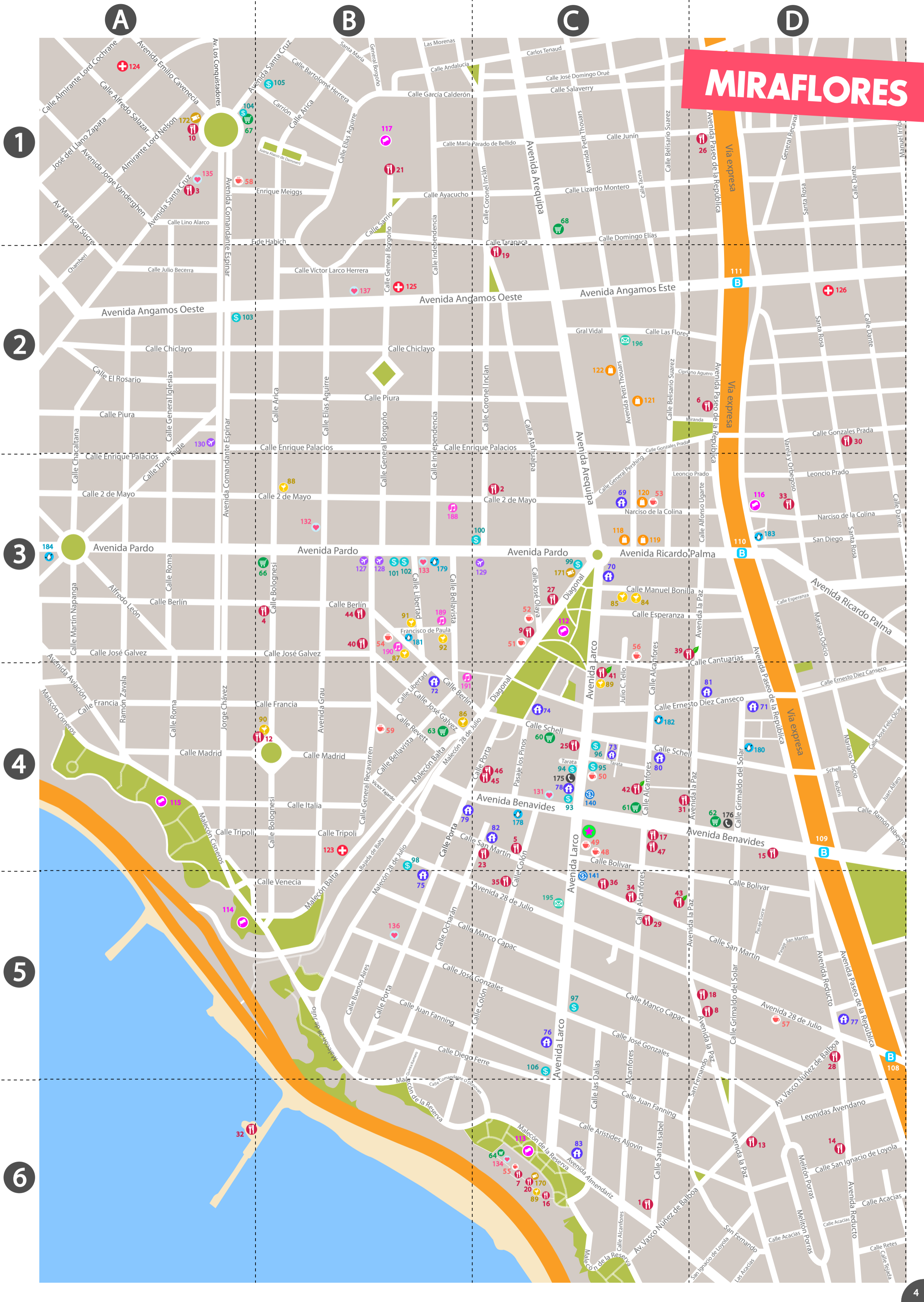
SEA FOOD

- **Cebiche/Ceviche:** Fresh raw fish or seafood cooked in citrus juices and spiced with aji. Mixed with fresh onions and other herbs.
- **Tiradito:** Fresh raw fish cut sashimi style, cooked in citrus juices and usually covered in a lightly creamy, slightly spicy sauce.
- **Choritos a la Chalaca:** Mussels, corn, onions, tomatoes, herbs, and seasoned citrus juice served on a mussel shell.
- **Arroz con Mariscos:** Peruvian-style seafood risotto.
- **Chupe de Camarones:** Mildly spicy red chowder traditionally made with freshwater shrimp from Arequipa.
- **Escabeche:** Pan fried fillets of fish with chopped onions and yellow peppers, all in a sweet and sour red aji pepper sauce.

DESERTS

- **Picarones:** Smashed sweet potato and squash deep fried in a doughnut shape and served with chancaca syrup (fig & molasses).
- **Turrón:** Layered, anise flavored cookie cake bathed in chancaca syrup, topped with caramels and candies.
- **Suspiro a la Limeña:** Golden and silky smooth caramel-like base, crowned with a light and creamy liqueur meringue.
- **Tres Leches:** Vanilla sponge cake soaked in three different kinds of milk: condensed, evaporated, and whipped cream.

HOW TO...

Buy a SIM card and top-up your phone

Buying a SIM card at "Claro"

- 1) Make sure to bring: Your original passport, 15 soles in cash (or a credit/debit card), and an unlocked cellphone. If you don't have an unlocked phone, you can buy a very basic phone for 40-50 soles.
- 2) Go to **CLARO** (largest phone provider in Peru). Their closest office is located very close to School at Avenida Larco 652. Find it on our Miraflores map (Page 4, map section C4, business #175).
- 3) Wait in line at the reception counter (just after the entrance) to get a ticket number to see a sales representative. Then wait for your ticket number to be called, which will be shown on the tv screens.
- 4) Tell the sales representative that you need a new pay-as-you-go SIM card ('**Quisiera comprar un nuevo chip prepago**'). After completing your registration, he/she will ask you to make a 15 soles payment at the register ('**caja**' in Spanish). Please note that the register is at a separate counter.
- 5) After completing your payment, go back to the sales representative to receive your new SIM card. Then insert it into your phone and enjoy!

Topping-up your phone

You can top up your phone at the nearest supermarket, drug store, or gas station. Just ask the cashier for a '**recarga virtual**', provide your cellphone number (9 digits), and the amount of money you want to put into your line account. For example:

'**Quisiera hacer una recarga virtual de 20 soles para mi celular Claro. Mi número de celular es 987090100**' (You are saying: I'd like to top up my Claro line with 20 soles. My cellphone number is 987090100).

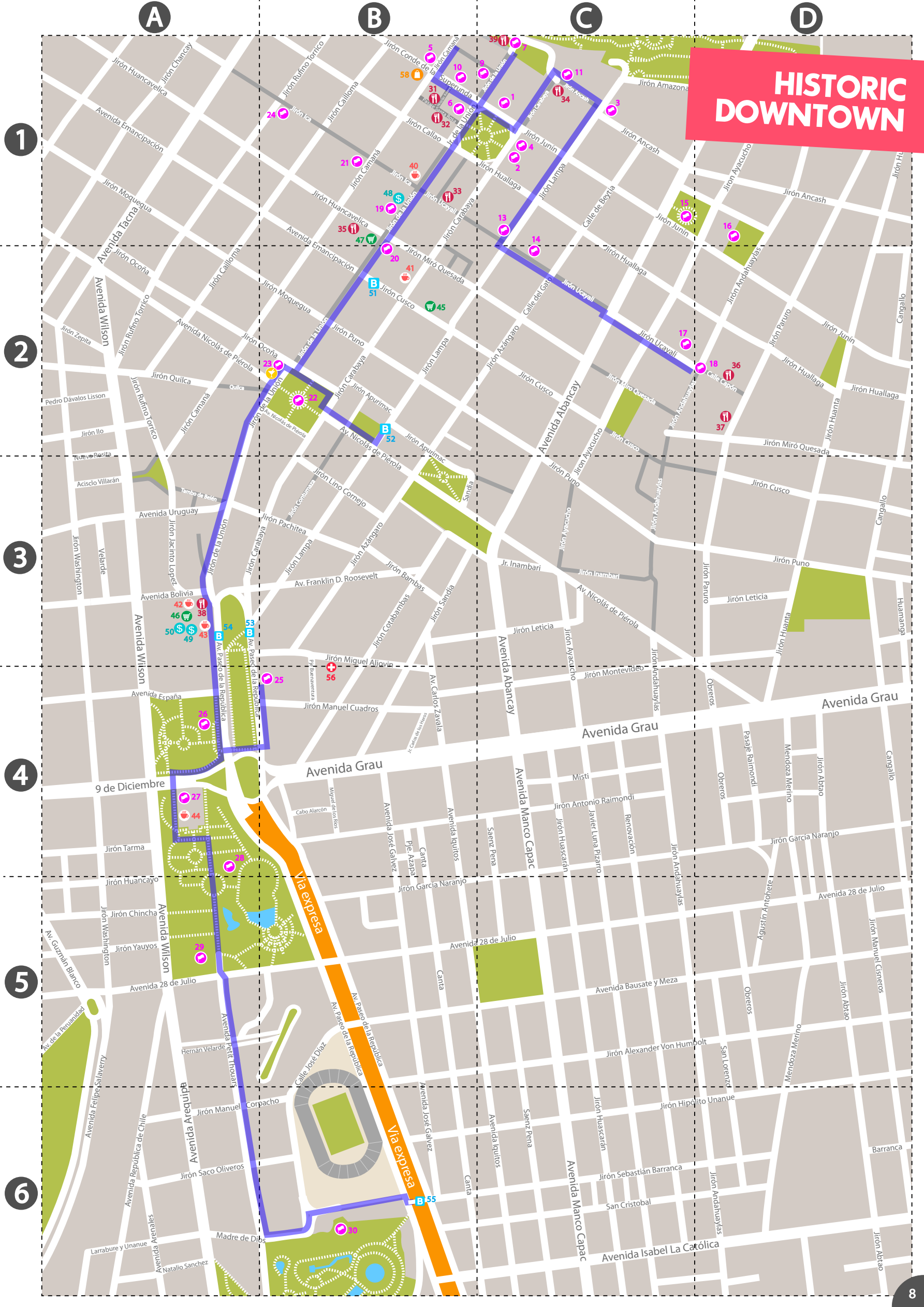

DO NOT use data without activating a package first. To do so, simply send a text message to the number 779 with the **key word** of your choice (see chart on the left). **For example:** Text **30S** to the number 779 to activate 2GB of data for 30 soles.

How much is enough?: For example, 2GB = 89 hours to surf the web.

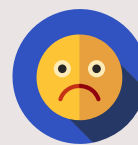

TAXIMETERS AREN'T USED

Taximeters aren't used in Peru. Instead, exact prices are negotiated with taxi drivers before getting into the cab. Prices depend on distance, time of day, and expected traffic. Please use the above chart as a guide for prices to popular destinations.

CAREFUL! Many times taxi drivers hailed in the street may try to take advantage of out of towners, including foreign tourists, so it is important that you haggle with confidence. Hopefully the eventual price you agree on will be within a few soles of the prices quoted above.



WHICH STREET TAXI?

A large number of taxis in Peru are unlicensed, and we strongly recommend avoiding them. These taxis are normally older vehicles, and won't have any taxi regalia or roof lights (they just have a small sticker glued on the windscreen that says "Taxi"). Try choosing taxis that have credible features, i.e. license numbers printed on both sides of the passenger doors. Another good sign when taking a taxi is a polite and friendly driver.



TAXIS OUTSIDE THE AIRPORT

We strongly discourage everyone (even locals) from getting a taxi in the street outside the airport since they are informal and in many cases not safe to use. Instead, we suggest using **TAXI GREEN** which is the most reliable and safe taxi company you can get for airport pick ups. They charge 60 soles to Miraflores (about \$20) and there's no need to make a reservation ahead of time. Just make sure to go to their counter kiosk located at the arrivals hall, open 24/7. Their drivers wear suits and carry official Taxi Green ID's, and they will assign you a driver at that very moment.

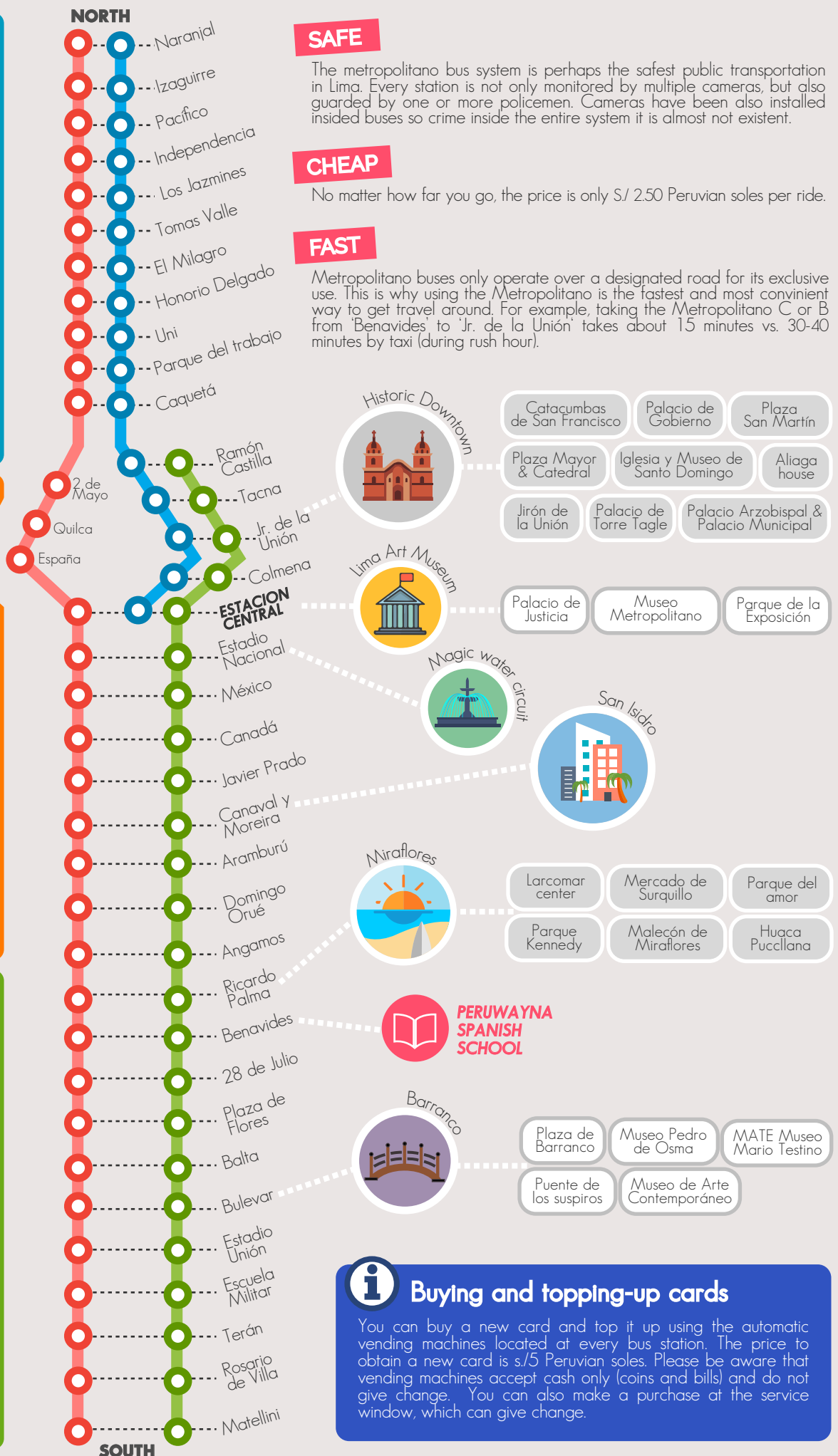

The metropolitan bus system is perhaps the safest public transportation in Lima. Every station is not only monitored by multiple cameras, but also guarded by one or more policemen. Cameras have been also installed inside buses so crime inside the entire system it is almost not existent.

No matter how far you go, the price is only S/ 2.50 Peruvian soles per ride.

FAST

Metropolitano buses only operate over a designated road for its exclusive use. This is why using the Metropolitano is the fastest and most convenient way to get travel around. For example, taking the Metropolitano C or B from 'Benavides' to 'Jr. de la Unión' takes about 15 minutes vs. 30-40 minutes by taxi (during rush hour).

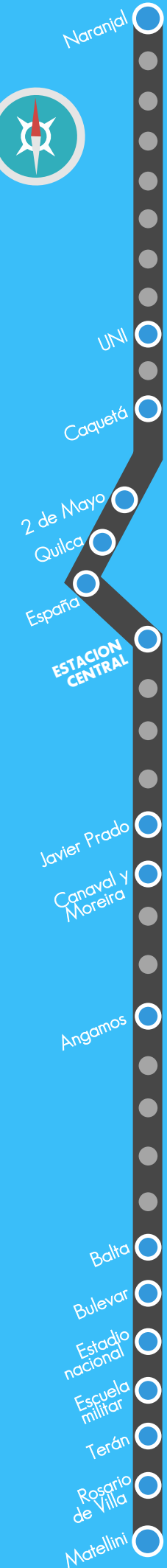


Buying and topping-up cards

Van services are easy to find in the north of Peru, where these are frequently used to cover shorter routes (30 min - 3 hours) such as: Piura>Mancora / Tumbes>Mancora / Piura > Punta Sal, etc.

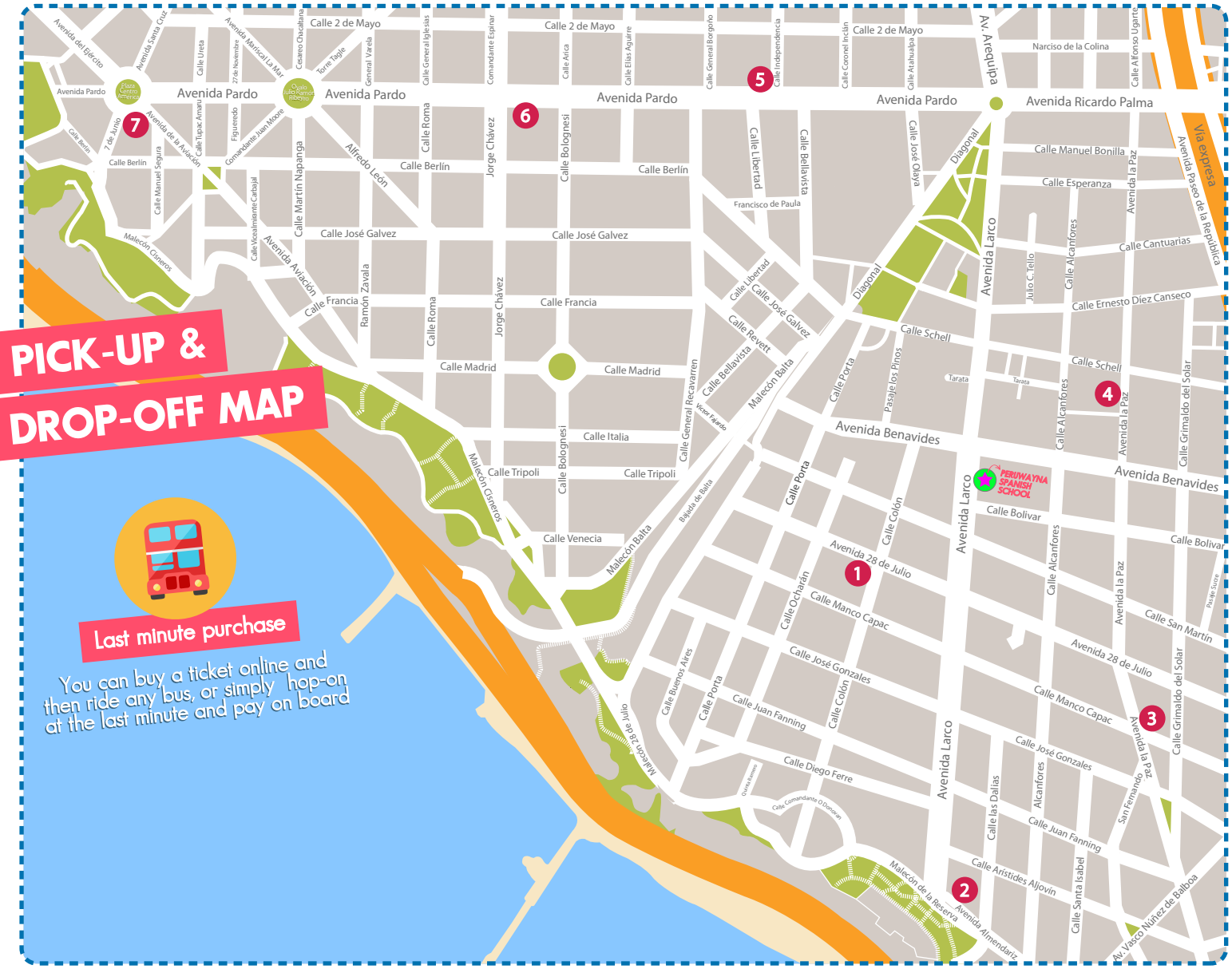
